


English

Monkey see monkey do

The children will be exploring this cultural story set in India through drama and role play and using talk for writing techniques to learn it by heart with actions. They will then innovate the narrative to produce their own independent stories about animals in the jungle. After this, we will look at non-fiction writing techniques and research and collate some of our own fact sheets about animals of our choice.

JOURNEY TO THE JUNGLE



Science

The children will explore the topic of animals, sorting and classifying them and investigating food chains and lifecycles as well as animal habitats including those found in the continent of Asia.



Maths

We will be focusing on multiplication and division, using practical, pictorial and mental method including knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

We will end the term looking at money. The children will learn to recognise and use different coins and understand the different monetary symbols, and begin to solve problems using money.



Art, Music and DT



All children will be leaning the violin in their weekly music sessions with a music specialist. We will be reading 'The Tin Forest' and using different materials to sculpt, model and collage.

P.E



Children will be continuing to explore travelling and balancing routines in gymnastics, incorporating the apparatus and equipment.



R.E

We will be learning about what Christians believe God is like. We will discuss parables, including story of the lost son and the lost sheep.



Geography

The children will be exploring Mumbai, India and comparing it to our local area in terms of cultural and ecological similarities and differences. We will also be looking at continents and oceans and learning their names.

Forest School



The children will Build and be responsible for a camp fire, learn camp songs, and forest games. We will whittle sticks for the fire, to toast marshmallows. We will make hedgehog houses, and bug hotels
