

English

In our English work this term, we are going to be looking at the work of J.K Rowling in 'The Polyjuice Potion' (an extract from one of her Harry Potter novels). In addition, the children are going to be writing their own story, based on potions. We are also carrying out persuasive writing this term and looking at the Sugar Tax debate, giving the children an opportunity to debate a current issue in the news. We are finishing the term with Macbeth, which leads us into our Summer performance.

Science

Solutions: Know that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution, and describe how to recover a substance from a solution.

Separation: Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating.

Demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes.

Explain that some changes result in the formation of new materials, and that this kind of change is not usually reversible, including changes associated with burning and the action of acid on bicarbonate of soda.
