

## English

This term, in English, we will be studying the book 'Wonder' by R.J.Palacio. During this book study, we will be looking at the use of inference, especially in the way people act (body language) and the emotions which are shown through speech. We will be focusing our writing on narrative diary entries throughout this topic. We are also going to be looking at autobiographies and the work of Roald Dahl in his book 'Boy'. We are also going to study narrative poetry this term and have a go at creating some narrative poems of our own focused on 'The Wonder of Me'.

## Science

In Science this term, we are going to be looking at the human body and features of animals. We will be making lots of comparisons between both humans and different types of animals. In addition, we will look closer at body parts, such as our teeth, stomach and intestines. We will be taking part in fun team activities such as becoming 'experts' and teaching our expertise to others.
