Cricket World Cup

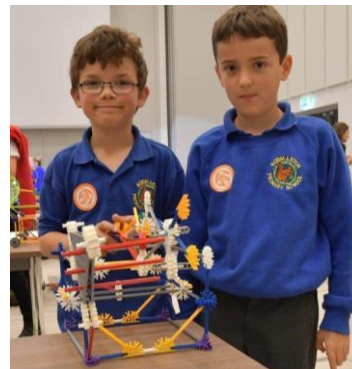

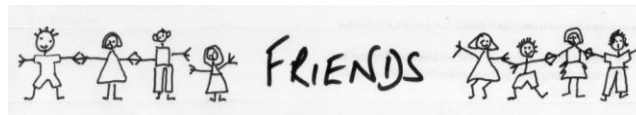


Imagination Award
