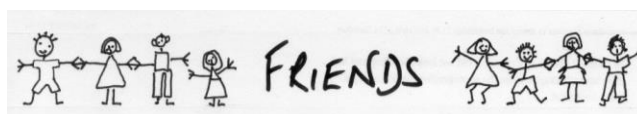


### Imagination Award
