Parents are also invited to enter the Cake Competition around the theme of family and these will be auctioned at 3:30pm.



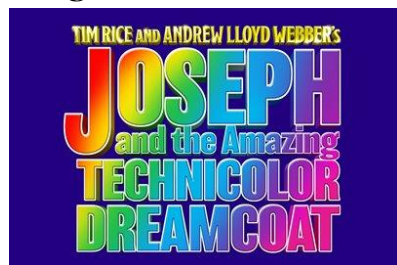

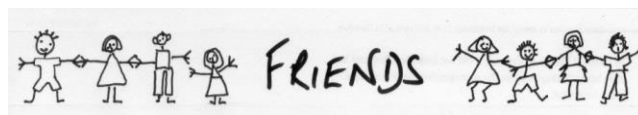
