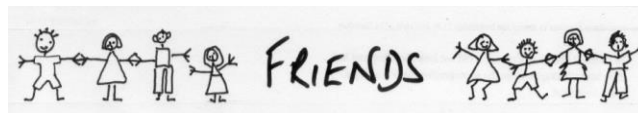


Imagination Award
