

## **English**

This term, we are going to begin our fiction work by studying the novel, 'When Hitler Stole Pink Rabbit' by Judith Kerr. Through this, we will follow a child's journey through the war (Anna) who is from a Jewish family living (originally) in Germany. After this, we will be writing our own fictional war novels, based on the work of Judith Kerr. We will go on to study war poetry. After this, we will focus on propaganda and the use of persuasion.

## **History & Geography**

In topic, we will be looking at the outbreak of war, where when and why the war took place back in the 1940's. In addition, we will be looking at evacuation, rationing, the role of woman and propaganda. We will also be studying The Holocaust and key events, such as The Battle of Britain and the attack on Pearl Harbour.

## **Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar**

Spelling will focus on: silent letters, homophones, suffixes (ly), and words with /s/ spelt sc. In punctuation and grammar, we will look at: determiners, prepositions, conjunctions and sophisticated punctuation techniques.

## **Spanish**

In Spanish, we are going to look at New Year and Epiphany. Followed by revision of days of the week and hobbies. We will learn how to talk about sport in Spanish as well as a revision on numbers.

## **PSHE**

We are going to look at friends and family, healthy and unhealthy relationships and what affects our feelings and behaviour.

## **Maths**
