

English

This term, we are going to begin by looking at a Roman myth 'Romulus and Remus' which focuses on how the city of Rome came to be. Following on from this, we will be innovating the myth, writing contrasting diaries and then inventing our own myths based on stories from Ancient Rome.

We will also be looking at the story 'Escape from Pompeii' and writing our own non-chronological 'double page spread' reports on Ancient Rome.

History & Geography

In topic, we will be studying the growth of the Roman Empire after the successful invasions. The children will study resistance to the Roman army and how the Romans shaped Britain. We will be drawing on local geographical knowledge to see how Roman history shaped the world we live in today.

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

In the same format as last term, our weekly spelling patterns will be uploaded onto **Spelling Shed**. In SPAG lessons, we will be focusing on direct speech, embedding speech and building cohesion across paragraphs.

Spanish

In our Spanish lessons, we will be looking at families, pets and hobbies. The children will continue to consolidate their learning from last term before moving on to learn new terminology.


The Rotten Romans Summer Term 2021

Maths

In Maths, we are going to start by looking at decimals (year 4/5) and ratio (year 6). We are going to move on to look at properties of shape. Our calculation lessons on Wednesdays will focus on the different four operations and how to solve problems using these.

Science

In Science, we are going to study light and sound. We will start by looking at sound, how it travels through the air and what the term 'pitch' means. As the term goes on, we will carry out an investigation into how sound travels based on our learning. We will study light in Summer term two, looking at reflection, refraction and how light is made up of a variety of colours. We will finish by studying the parts of the eye and their functions.



Art

Our art focus this term is Lino Tile Printing, with the focus on mosaics. We will look at the style of mosaics and repeating patterns, before designing and creating our own.

Computing

This term, we will be looking at coding and creating a topic themed quiz using Scratch. The children will be thinking about conditions and how to use algorithms effectively in technology.

DT

In DT, we are going to look at making Roman settlement models. We will study how they were made and then make our own mini versions!
