Dear Parents and Carers,

We were sad to hear that one of our pupils tested positive for covid- 19 this week and other children were absent, awaiting PCR test results. Although the rest of these tests have so far returned a negative result, we know that many of our families have been feeling poorly and I wish them better soon.

The Government's isolation guidance changed before the start of term and only children with symptoms should isolate and await the results of a PCR test. If your child does not have symptoms, they should attend school as normal, even if other pupils in the school test positive.

When we have situations such as this, it no doubt causes concern and worry. Please be assured that any actions that families need to take will be communicated directly to you.
